Saturday, June 18, 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Doors open for exhibitors at 8:30 a.m. Friday and 9:30 a.m. Saturday. This is a two-day show. Exhibitors must be ready at 9:30 a.m. and remain open during all show hours and until 5:00 p.m. Saturday. Check-In at EOWA table for booth assignment and packet. Tables will be in place Thursday. Building is locked overnight. Tables must be covered on top and all 4 sides to the floor (sheets not permitted).

Entry Fee: \$40.00 per space No refunds after, June 10, 2011. Rental Tables: \$10 each 8'x30"x30." Chairs & Pegboards are not provided. COMMERCIAL SPACES: first-come-first serve.

SATURDAY MORNING SHOW BREAKFAST

Breakfast is 8:00 a.m., Saturday, June 18, at the Union Middle School Commons, Cost is \$10 per person (all inclusive). The breakfast will be catered and consist of quality breakfast fare. Door prizes will be given. Exhibitors and guests are encouraged to donate a small item for the door prize drawings at the breakfast.

APPLICATIONS

THIS IS A WOODCARVING, WOODTURNING, WOODWORKING, PYROGRAPHY, SCROLLSAW, AND INTARSIA SHOW. Entries should be received no later than June 10, 2010. Late entries will be accepted based on cancellations. Exhibitors must sign Agreement on Application Form.

NON-COMMERCIAL EXHIBITS MUST BE AT LEAST 80 PERCENT WOOD-RELATED, WITH THE REMAINING 20 PERCENT RELATED TO SUPPLY ITEMS. NO BRONZE, STONE, OR MOLDED CARVINGS MAY BE SHOWN OR SOLD.

The Show Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any application and/or display and is the final authority on all show policies. First-time Show applicants are requested to submit pictures representative of their work with their application.

SEMINAR SCHEDULE

EOWA will present a beginners seminar Friday and Saturday afternoons carving a project from wood (adults) or high-density foam (youth) for ages 10 and up. Also scheduled are two

caricature carving seminars by Featured Artists Phil and Vicki Bishop. There will also be an intarsia seminar.

JUDGING

Open Category Judging begins at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, June 17; Novice Category immediately follows the Open judging. Judging is by teams that are trained and assigned by the EOWA. Competition is open only to exhibitors present at the show. Awards will be presented immediately following.

Exhibitors Choice: Voting for Exhibitors Choice is Friday, 1:00 to 2:00 p.m. with entries limited to blue ribbon winners.

Peoples Choice: Each exhibitor will be allowed one entry for Peoples Choice (**any piece winning Peoples Choice in a previous EOWA show is not eligible to be entered**).

Instructions for Peoples Choice voting and exhibiting will be included in the exhibitor packets. People's Choice award voting opens 2:00 p.m. Friday and closes Saturday, 12:00 noon. Award presentation at 12:30 p.m.

A.B. SMITH MEMORIAL CARVING CONTEST.

A carving contest, open to exhibitors only, will be held on Saturday, from 11 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. Contestants are limited to one knife blade, one pencil, and one sharpening device. A blank, the subject of which remains secret until contest time, is furnished at no charge. Judging and Awards will be made at the close of the contest.

PURCHASE AWARDS

Show Exhibitors may present two entries for each price category on Saturday at 2:00 p.m.

SALES

Sales are permitted. Sales tax is the responsibility of exhibitors possessing an Oklahoma Sales Tax Permit (submit your permit number with entry form). If you do not possess an Oklahoma tax permit, you will be required to submit a tax report to the EOWA with the collected tax at the end of the show. EOWA will provide the form and instructions in your exhibitor packet.

DOOR PRIZES

EOWA draws for door prizes for visitors hourly. If you would like to contribute a door prize please bring it to the EOWA club table. The club encourages a donation of a small carved, turned or sawn item, small rough-out or other wood or craft related item. Thank you.

2011 JUDGING CATEGORIES

Each exhibitor is limited to one (1) entry per category. Additional credit may be given for originality. **Any item winning a BLUE ribbon in any previous EOWA Show is not eligible.** Category must have a minimum of two pieces entered to be judged. Single items from un-judged categories will be placed in the MISCELLANEOUS category. The Miscellaneous Category is only for un-judged category items. All decisions by the judging committee are final.

WOODCARVING CATEGORIES

Relief

1. **High** -Any subject, any finish (includes pierced relief).
2. **Low** -Any subject, any finish (no piercing or undercutting).

Chip Carving (excludes fragmentation, high, low, and pierced relief).

3. **Flat** – any subject, any finish.
 4. **Three-Dimensional** – any subject, any finish.
 5. **Gouge** – any subject, any finish.
6. **Carousel & Mythical Figures:** Single or group any finish.
7. **Carved Walking Stick & Canes:** Any type of walking stick and cane will be in this category, any finish.
8. **Carved Footwear:** any type, any finish.

Realistic

9. **Human Bust** – single, any finish.
10. **Human Full Figure** – single, any finish.
11. **Marine Life** – single, any finish.
12. **Bird of Prey** – single any finish.
13. **Songbird** – single, any finish.
14. **Game Bird** – single, any finish.
15. **Waterfowl** – single, any finish.
16. **Shorebird** – single, any finish.
17. **Animal** – single, natural finish.
18. **Animal** – single, painted finish.
19. **Group Same Subject** – any finish.
20. **Group Mixed** – two or more species, any finish.

Artistic or Stylized

21. **Wildlife** – single or group, natural finish, grain must show.
22. **Human** – single or group, natural finish, grain must show.
23. **Abstract** – free-form object, natural finish, grain must show.

Caricature

24. **Human** – single figure, any finish.
25. **Human Bust** – single, any finish.
26. **Wildlife, Animal, Bird or Marine Life** – single, any finish.

Caricature continued...

27. **Group Mixed** – two or more species, any finish.
 28. **Group Same Subject** -any finish.
29. **Driftwood, Bark or Log Carving** -any subject, any finish.
30. **Miniature** – must not exceed 2" x 2" x 2", any finish.
31. **Religious** – any finish (may represent any religious philosophy).
32. **Holiday** – any finish (secular holidays such as Valentine's, Halloween, Thanksgiving, Christmas/Santa Claus, etc.)

Pyrography

33. Non-carved item, any subject, natural finish.
 34. Non-carved item, any subject, painted finish.
35. **Whittled/Traditional** – items carved from a single piece of wood with one blade, no power tools, no assembling, any finish (i.e. chains, ball-in-cage, traditional folk patterns, etc.)
36. **Instructor assisted/Seminar Carving** – carvings created with extensive help from an instructor (i.e. using an instructor's blank, and/or carving on the piece by the instructor).
37. **Decorative Functional** – any subject, any finish with a specific function or use carved in (love spoons, bottle stoppers, etc.).
38. **Floral** – any finish.
39. **Miscellaneous** – Carvings from categories with only one entry.

Novice – one who has never won more than 3 blue ribbons in the Novice Category or 1 blue in an EOWA Open Competition.

40. **Realistic** – single or group, any finish.
41. **Stylized** – single or group, any finish.
42. **Caricature** – single or group, any finish.
43. **Chip Carvings, Relief & Walking Stick/Cane** – any finish.

WOODTURNING

44. **Spindle Turnings** – lamp base, candlesticks, turned between centers, turned furniture parts, letter openers, pens and pencils, lace bobbins, mallets, etc.
45. **Bowls** – face plate or chuck turned items with wide mouth; salad bowls, nut or fruit bowls, to include plates and platters.
46. **Hollow Vessels** – face plate or chuck turned items with a small opening (vases or urns).
47. **Turned Boxes with Lids** – jewelry, pill, mushroom boxes, etc., with sculptured profiles, boxes w/legs.
48. **Woodturnings w/Fancy Decorations** – any woodturning with fancy decoration, such as carving, inlay, intarsia, coloration, segmentation, lacing, piercing, attached cords, feathers, glass beads, etc.
49. **Any Other Turned Object** – any turned piece that cannot be reasonably placed within one of the preceding categories.

SCROLL SAW

50. **Intarsia** – pictures made by cutting and shaping different kinds of wood.
51. **Decorative Functional** – items made to be decorative and provide a useful function, such as clocks and boxes.
52. **Wall Hangings** – items cut to provide a scene or saying (excludes shelves).
53. **Ornaments** – items cut as ornaments, such as fan pulls, Christmas ornaments, etc.
54. **Three-Dimensional Items** – items cut and assembled to provide a decorative piece, but does not have a function other than decorative.
55. **Toys** – items for play

There are no woodworking categories for judging.

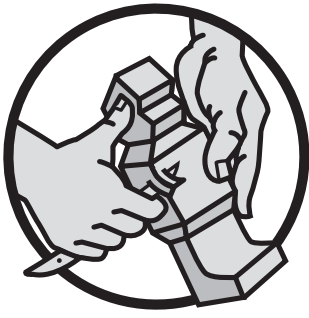
